MEETING HELD OCTOBER 2, 2012

PERRY TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES MET IN REGULAR SESSION, CALLED TO ORDER AT 7:30 BY CHAIRPERSON NORM CAPPS, KEVIN COX & GREG KESSEN WERE PRESENT. ROLLCALL BY FISCAL OFFICER. THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE FOLLOWED.

KEVIN COX MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MEETING MINUTES FROM SEPTEMBER 18TH WITH 2ND BY GREG KESSEN, ROLLCALL.

GREG KESSEN MADE A MOTION TO PAY THE BILLS OF \$35,325.11, WITH A 2^{ND} BY KEVIN COX, ROLLCALL.
