MINUTES OF PERRY TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES

MEETING
HELD JANUARY 25, 2013

PERRY TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES MET IN SPECIAL SESSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF NECESSITY OF ADDITIONAL TAX LEVY, CALLED TO ORDER AT 11:00 BY CHAIRPERSON KEVIN COX, NORM CAPPS & GREG KESSEN WERE PRESENT. ROLLCALL BY FISCAL OFFICER. THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE FOLLOWED.

GREG KESSEN MOVED FOR RESOLUTION #130125-01 DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF LEVYING A TAX UNDER OHIO REVISED CODE 5705.03 OUTSIDE THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION MUST BE PASSED AND CERTIFIED TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR OF ALLEN COUNTY IN ORDER TO PERMIT THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO CONSIDER THE LEVY OF SUCH A TAX AND MUST REQUEST THAT THE COUNTY AUDITOR CERTIFY TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF PERRY TOWNSHIP AND THE NUMBER OF MILLS REQUIRED TO GENERATE A SPECIFIED AMOUNT OF REVENUE. THERE IS A NECESSITY TO LEVY AN ADDITIONAL ONE MILL GENERAL LEVY IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION FOR THE BENEFIT OF PERRY TOWNSHIP FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE PAYING THE CURRENT OPERATING EXPENSES OF PERRY TOWNSHIP, 2ND BY NORM CAPPS, ROLLCALL.

THE BOARD PROPOSES THAT THIS LEVY WOULD BE A 10 YEAR LEVY EFFECTIVE JANUARY 2014. IT WAS DISCUSSED TO BE A GENERAL LEVY TO BETTER SERVE THE TOWNSHIP WHERE THE MONEY IS NEEDED.

GREG KESSEN MADE A MOTION TO PROPOSE THIS 1 MILL LEVY TO BE A 10 YEAR LEVY EFFECTIVE JANUARY 2014, 2ND BY NORM CAPPS, ROLLCALL.

GUEST – GENE DAVIS – GUEST AGREES THAT THIS IS A GOOD IDEA BECAUSE THE MONEY CAN BE DIVIDED UP WHERE IT IS NEEDED.
