MINUTES OF PERRY TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES

MEETING HELD February 5, 2013

PERRY TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES MET IN REGULAR SESSION, CALLED TO ORDER AT 7:30 BY CHAIRPERSON KEVIN COX, NORM CAPPS & GREG KESSEN WERE PRESENT. ROLLCALL BY FISCAL OFFICER. THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE FOLLOWED.

NORM CAPPS MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE CORRECTED MEETING MINUTES FROM JANUARY 15 WITH 2^{ND} BY GREG KESSEN, ROLLCALL.

THE BOARD MET WITH DICK KRIENBRINK THE FOLLOWING FRIDAY AFTER THE MEETING TO DISCUSS THE RAILROAD ON AMHERST RD.

NORM CAPPS MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MEETING MINUTES FROM JANUARY 25TH WITH 2ND BY GREG KESSEN, ROLLCALL.

NATALIE SCOTT, FISCAL OFFICER -

NORM CAPPS MADE A MOTION TO PAY THE BILLS OF \$53,143.42 WITH A 2^{ND} BY GREG KESSEN, ROLLCALL.

ALBERT SUNIGA - FROM ALLEN COUNTY SOIL AND WATER — HERE TO UPDATE ON SITE REVIEWS. THEIR OFFICE COVERED 23 SITE REVIEWS. PERRY TOWNSHIP HAD TWO SITE REVIEWS DURING 2012. ALBERT AND HIS OFFICE WERE ABLE TO HELP TWO OWNERS BEFORE THEY MADE A BAD INVESTMENT BUYING LAND THEY COULDN'T BUILD ON.

THE OLD GRANT IS ALMOST OVER WITH. ALBERT IS HERE TO GET THE TOWNSHIP ON BOARD WITH CONTINUING TO SUPPORT THE SITE REVIEW PROGRAM. THE PROGRAM REQUIRES A SITE REVIEW TO BE DONE BEFORE A LOT SPLIT. THIS PROGRAM WILL COST THE TOWNSHIP \$1,000 ANNUALLY. NO DECISION IS MADE AT THIS TIME.

CHRISTINE PLEVA – GUEST FROM LIMA/ALLEN COUNTY CONVENTION AND VISITORS BUREAU TO GIVE THE ANNUAL DIRECTORS REPORT.

ALLEN COUNTY TOURISM WAS UP 9.9%, PERRY TOWNSHIP WAS UP 13.06%, 943 GROUPS CAME TO THE COUNTY, \$ 47.7 MILLION PEOPLE, 12.25% OF AN INCREASE IN DOLLARS GENERATED. THERE WAS 30 NEW EVENTS IN THE COUNTY. THE BUREAU HAS BEEN WORKING WITH ODOT TO WORK AROUND THE ROAD CONSTRUCTION THAT WILL HAPPEN IN 2013. ALL OF THE EVENTS ARE AWARE OF THE ROAD CONSTRUCTION AND WILL BE HELPED TO RE-ROUTE.

THEY HAVE UPDATED THEIR WEBSITE DURING THE YEAR SO THEY CAN BETTER TRACK VIEWERS. THEY HAD 2.37 MILLION INFORMATION REQUESTS IN 2012, 1.4 MILLION PAGES VIEWED IN 2012. ALL STATISTICS ARE AVAILABLE IN THE ANNUAL REPORT SUBMITTED TO THE TOWNSHIP.

GREG KESSEN MOVED TO RESCIND THE MOTION ON JANUARY 25^{TH} FOR PROPOSED 10 YEAR 1.0 MILL LEVY, 2^{ND} BY NORM CAPPS, ROLLCALL.

GREG KESSEN MOVED TO PROPOSE A 5 YEAR 1.0 MILL LEVY BEGINNING IN 2014, 2^{ND} BY NORM CAPPS, ROLLCALL.

GREG KESSEN MOVED FOR RESOLUTION #130205-02, FOR RESOLUTION TO PROCEED TO PUT 1.0 MILL GENERAL LEVY. THIS 1.0 MILL GENERAL LEVY WILL GENERATE \$92,718 ANNUALLY BASED ON CURRENT ASSESSED VALUATION OF THE TOWNSHIP, 2ND BY NORM CAPPS, ROLLCALL.

GREG KESSEN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE TOWNSHIP PARTICIPATION FOR 2013 WITH OTTAWA RIVER COALITION PER MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT, 2ND BY NORM CAPPS, ROLLCALL.

GREG KESSEN MADE A MOTION TO MAKE KEVIN COX AS THE VOTING REPRESENTATIVE FOR OTTAWA RIVER COALITION FOR 2013 FOR PERRY TOWNSHIP. GREG KESSEN WILL BE THE ALTERNATIVE VOTING REPRESENTATIVE, 2^{ND} BY NORM CAPPS, ROLLCALL.

GUESTS

DIETER WIREMAN – GUEST IS CONCERNED THAT THE RESIDENTS WILL NOT UNDERSTAND WHAT A NEW LEVY MEANS. DIETER ALSO FEELS THAT THE FIRE DEPARTMENT EQUIPMENT IS OLD AND WE SHOULD BE BUYING NEWER EQUIPMENT IF WE HAVE A SUCH A BIG CARRYOVER. DIETER ALSO FEELS WE ARE UNDER STAFFED.

DARREL STYER - GUEST IS ALSO CONCERNED THAT RESIDENTS WILL SEE THE GENERAL FUND CARRY FORWARD. DOES NOT THINK IT'S RIGHT THAT WE TAKE MONEY AWAY FROM THE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

THE BOARD FOLLOWED WITH DISCUSSION ABOUT FIRE DEPARTMENT. THE BOARD IS NOT AWARE OF ANY UNDERSTAFFING ISSUES AT THIS TIME. THE NEW LEVY WILL ALLOW THE TOWNSHIP TO BETTER SERVE THE RESIDENTS BY ALLOWING THE FUNDS TO BE DELEGATED BETWEEN ROAD, POLICE AND FIRE WHEN NEEDED. THE TOWNSHIP WILL ALLOW A 1 MILL FIRE LEVY TO EXPIRE IF THE NEW GENERAL LEVY IS PASSED. IT COSTS THE TOWNSHIP \$70,000 TO \$80,000 TO PAVE A MILE OF ROAD.
