General Specifications:

1. All construction must comply with the ALLEN COUNTY STANDARD CONSTRUCTION DRAWINGS.
 2. The Perry Township Trustees assumes no liability for any damages that may occur to the applicant or their property as the result of any drainage obstruction directly or indirectly caused by the discharge of effluent into said tile.
 3. Traffic will be maintained at all times, unless permission is granted by Perry Township to do otherwise.
 4. The necessary lights, signs, barricades, flagmen and watchmen are maintained for the protection of traffic at all times, day and night, as instructed by Perry Township until work is completed.
 5. If the roadway pavement, roadside shoulders, tiles or ditches are damaged either by construction or equipment the property owner/contractor will completely restore the right-of-way and all infrastructure at their expense as deemed necessary by Perry Township.
 6. The performance bond for small project, road bore and road cut will not be returned to the applicant until the construction meets the specifications set forth by Perry Township, the Perry Township Inspector, and the Allen County Standard Construction Drawings.
 7. The applicant and/ or contractor shall guarantee that the work shall be free from any defects in workmanship and materials for a period of not less than one (1) year from the date of completion thereof. The applicant and or contractor shall be responsible for the replacement or repair, without additional charge, of all work done or furnished in accordance with its permit which shall become defective within one (1) year after completion of the work done under this permit.
 8. The performance bond for large project will not be returned to the applicant until one (1) year after the construction meets the specifications set forth by Perry Township, the Perry Township Inspector, and the Allen County Standard Construction Drawings.
 9. If the 180 day period between the date the permit is issued and the completion of the work is not met, the applicant will forfeit all permit fees. The permit holder must submit a new permit application along with all of the standard permit fees to Perry Township. The performance bond from the original permit will be transferred to the new permit.
 10. Any and all pavement repair work on Township Roads shall be performed by a qualified paving contractor using qualified materials, labor and equipment.
 11. All utilities placed under the roadway shall maintain a minimum of 48" of clearance below the surface of the ground and roadway.
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Section 1: Utility Installation:

1. State fully and completely on this permit application the type of utility installation proposed.
 - If pole line, give the following information:
 - Number of poles, total length of line, type of wire, character of service, vertical clearance over pavement, and voltage, if power line.
 - If pipe, conduit or cable, give the following information:
 - Type of service (water, oil, gas, sanitary sewer, storm sewer, electric, telephone); if carrying liquid or gas under pressure, state pounds per square inch, internal diameter and kind of pipe, length of line; type of conduit or cable and length; and proposed location with respect to pavement or right of way line. If pipe, conduit or cable is to cross highway and crossing cannot be made without disturbing pavement, advise conditions requiring such method of installation. All utilities placed under the roadway shall maintain a minimum of 48" clearance below the surface of the ground and roadway.
 2. Give County Road or Township Road and distance from some geographical point, such as intersecting highways, city or village corporate limits, section lines, etc.
 3. Attach two (2) copies of plan showing proposed location with reference to pavement, right of way line, and owner's property lines. If installation crosses the highway, show cross section of present roadway and proposed installation. Plan should also show information listed under item (2).
 4. Any installation which cannot be made without opening the pavement requires the applicant to do the following:
 - State conditions preventing the installation under pavement by driving or boring.
 - Give specific dimensions since pavement replacement costs will be checked against information.
 - Contractor performing work will at the applicants expense:
 - Replace the pavement, in accordance with all ALLEN COUNTY STANDARD CONSTRUCTION DRAWINGS.
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Section 2: Tile Tap and Catch Basin Specifications:

1. The proposed tile tap will be for the purpose of EFFLUENT DISCHARGE only from a septic system.
 - No permit will be issued which is intended to discharge effluent from downspouts or water softeners.
 - Sump pumps and other drainage outlets will be evaluated at the time of application.
 2. Solid Schedule 35 or HDPE Conduit and Connections with smooth interior walls must be utilized in the road right-of-way.
 3. The Connection shall be made by means of a manufactured "Y" Connection or directly into the basin as outlined in *ALLEN COUNTY STANDARD CONSTRUCTION DRAWING TAP-TY & CB*.
 4. The tile, catch basins, and manholes installed in the road right-of-way must be backfilled as outlined in *ALLEN COUNTY STANDARD CONSTRUCTION DRAWING BFT-2*.
 5. A storm sewer clean-out and cap must be installed at the existing road right-of-way line as outlined in *ALLEN COUNTY STANDARD CONSTRUCTION DRAWING TAP-TY & CB*.
 6. The applicant will notify the Perry Township Inspector 24 hours prior to backfilling the trench. If this advanced notice is not made and the trench is backfilled, the applicant will forfeit \$100.00 of the bond, and the property owner/contractor will be required to expose the connection and the tile in the road right-of-way and then contact the Perry Township Inspector for approval.
 7. The granting of this permit shall not release the applicant from his/her legal responsibility to meet all effluent quality standards required by the Allen County Health Department and the Ohio E.P.A..
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Section 3: Tile Installation Specifications:

1. Backfill all tile installations as outlined in *ALLEN COUNTY STANDARD CONSTRUCTION DRAWINGS BFB-1, BFT-1& BFT-2*. The standard construction drawings have specific instructions on the type of backfill to be used based on the location of the opening in relation to the roadway.
2. Place a minimum of six (6) inches of asphalt as a wearing surface (Done by Contractor, if needed (cost will be taken out of bond)).

Also include the following information:

- A. Distance construction will occur off edge of pavement _____ feet.
- B. Average width of open trench _____ feet.
- C. Average depth of open trench _____ feet.
- D. If construction is by plowing method, state average depth _____ feet.

Section 4: Road Bore Specifications:

1. Place a minimum of six (6) inches of asphalt as a wearing surface (Done by Contractor, if needed (cost will be taken out of bond)).

Also include the following information:

- A. Distance bore pits will be constructed off edge of pavement _____ feet.
- B. Size of bore pits: _____ feet long by _____ feet wide by _____ feet deep.

Section 5: Road Cut Specifications:

1. The Perry Township will not supply the "Road Closed" signs. It is the contractor's responsibility to place and maintain these signs on the road during construction as per the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (O.M.U.T.C.D.).
2. The contractor will saw cut the road on both sides of the trench, one foot wider than the trench on each side (a minimum of four feet wide, as outlined in *ALLEN COUNTY STANDARD CONSTRUCTION DRAWINGS RC-1*).
3. Place a minimum of six (6) inches of asphalt as a wearing surface (this work is to be performed by asphalt contractor).
4. The contractor must provide plates to cover the exposed trench from the time it is excavated until contractor places the asphalt (within 5 working days).
5. The contractor must also read and sign the "SUPPLEMENTAL FORM TO OPEN CUT A ROAD" and return it with this application.

Also include the following information:

- A. Conditions necessitating open cutting of pavement

- B. The opening in the pavement will be approximately _____ feet long by _____ feet wide by _____ feet deep.

Section 6: Agricultural Purposes Specifications:

1. The applicant must give at least twenty four (24) hour notice prior to closing the road.
2. The Perry Township will deliver the "Road Closed" signs to the area on the day before the closure. The signs will be set in the roadside ditch at the nearest intersections on each side of the proposed road closing and make the necessary notifications.
3. Contractor will erect the "Road Closed" signs on the day of the closure.
4. The road shall only be closed during daylight hours.
5. The road cannot be closed until all school buses have passed in the morning (if school is in session).
6. The road must be open to allow school buses to pass in the afternoon (if school is in session).
7. The road must be open to allow emergency vehicles to pass at all times.
8. The applicant may close the road for a maximum of four (4) hours every six (6) months and no more than two (2) times per calendar year.
9. The applicant agrees to protect the traveling public at all times and indemnify and save harmless Perry Township against any damage that may occur through the use of this permit.
